



Is my life jacket correct?

It's not enough to simply wear a life jacket, it must fit correctly in order to be effective.

- 1 Selection**
Select the right jacket based on weight. Wearing a jacket that is too big can be dangerous.
- 2 The Right Fit**
The jacket should fit snug around the chest and should not ride up on your body in the water.
- 3 Ready, Set, Swim**
Fasten all buckles. Pull straps tight, not twisted. Smaller jackets will also have a strap for between the legs for added protection.



SAFE SWIMMER TIPS

- Life jackets are not babysitters
- Life jackets do not replace the need for active supervision
- Know your limits, even the best swimmer can drown
- Beware of rivers, they can be unpredictable and dangerous
- Have a swim buddy, learn CPR, and call 911 immediately
